



**DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS: April 30, 2022** 

Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents and should have completed their basic music training.

#### Purpose:

- 1. To foster excellence in the music of Christian worship
- 2. To assist a person pursuing a career in church music to follow a proposed programme of study directly applied to Christian worship.

#### Administration:

- The Lilian Forsyth Scholarship was initiated by Knox Presbyterian Church, Ottawa in 1981 upon the retirement of Lilian Forsyth as Director of Music. Charitable contributions to the Fund may be made to the Lilian Forsyth Scholarship Fund c/o Music Committee, Knox Presbyterian Church Ottawa. Income tax receipts will be issued by Knox Church.
- 2. The applications will be received by the Registrar of this Scholarship and will be adjudicated by a panel of church musicians and clergy.

#### Details:

- 1. The scholarship is normally \$2500. Funds are released to the winner only after proof of completion of the proposed programme of study and a written report are received. A timeline of two years is set for the use of the scholarship award.
- 2. The adjudicating panel may decide not to make an award in any given year.
- 3. The decisions of the adjudicating panel are final.
- 4. Previously unsuccessful applicants are eligible to re-apply in any succeeding year by submitting a completely new application package.

**LILIAN FORSYTH (1911-1982)** was a brilliant musician who devoted herself to the music of worship. It was as Director of Music at Knox Presbyterian Church, Ottawa, that she applied her talents as organist and choir director. For nearly fifty years, her selfless enthusiasm was felt in many musical organizations both in Ottawa and across the country. In 1967, she was chosen as one of six organists to play at Expo 67. In 1977, the Royal Canadian College of Organists awarding her an Honorary Fellowship. On her retirement in 1981, Knox Presbyterian Church established the Lilian Forsyth Scholarship as a tribute to her life and work.

THE LILIAN FORSYTH SCHOLARSHIP was established to foster excellence in the music of Christian worship. Since Lilian Forsyth was an exponent of the tradition of classical church music, preference will be given to applicants who follow that genre. The scholarship is aimed at persons pursuing a career in church music or actively involved in music directly related to the worship of the Christian community. This will include organists, choir directors, composers, and other musicians. It is preferable that such candidates should have completed their basic musical training. References must be submitted in all cases.

**EVALUATION** of the applications will be considered by a panel of musicians and clergy. The main criteria will be the potential of the candidate to gain musical knowledge, skill, and insight from the proposed program of study and to apply these directly to Christian worship. The amount of the scholarship may vary depending on the proposed program. The maximum is normally \$2,500, but the Kirk Session is not obligated to award the scholarship in any given year. Proof of enrollment in and completion of the proposed program will be required before the award will be released to the winning candidate. A written report to the Music Committee of Knox Presbyterian Church, Ottawa, also will be required after completion of the proposed program. A time limit of two years is set for use of the scholarship award. In exceptional circumstances, this may be extended at the discretion of the Kirk Session of Knox Presbyterian Church, Ottawa.

Previously unsuccessful candidates are eligible to reapply in any succeeding year by submitting a completely new application package.

#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE** Applicants must submit:

- A completed application form.
- ➤ A CD recording of the candidate's work. This recording must include a significant sampling of music and congregational singing recorded during a live service, preferably during a regular service in the candidate's own church. It may also include organ, voice or instrumental music performed by the candidate; choral music conducted or accompanied by the candidate; or music written by the candidate. The recording should be 20 to 30 minutes long and must have been recorded within the last twelve months. The recording should be clear but is not expected to be professionally recorded. Note: CDs will not be returned to the candidate.
- Three letters of reference on the form provided. One of the referees should be a minister or priest, preferably one with whom you have worked recently as a musician. The candidate is responsible for contacting the referees and obtaining the letters of reference, using the forms provided in the application. Once the form is completed, the referee is asked to insert the form in an envelope, seal the envelope and sign his or her name across the flap. The envelope should have the candidate's name on the front. The referee should return the sealed and signed envelope to the candidate who will forward it along with his or her application. Knox Presbyterian Church may contact the referee directly for further information.
